On Saturday, August 8, we gathered at Northside Presbyterian Church in Chattanooga for the 167th Stated Meeting of the Presbytery. Thank you to Northside for their warm hospitality and gracious welcome to their space.

The Vision Task Force led us in thoughtful and faithful worship. Cathy Meyer, barely back from Sabbatical, moderated with compassion and gratitude. We received Rev. Dr. Marvin Morgan into temporary membership as he serves as interim at Rivermont. We sustained the examination of Nolan Chilton for ordination and concurred in his call as the Associate Pastor at Westminster.

Northminster shared of their mission and ministry partnerships in the greater Chattanooga community and inspired us with what is possible as we seek to go where God calls.
